MINUTES OF 39th MEETING OF SENATE HELD ON 17TH DECEMBER 2019

The 39th meeting of Senate was held on 17th December 2019 at 3.00 PM in Malaviya Sabhagar, Prabha Bhawan of the Institute. "Academic Performance Requirement" and sub clause: 1. The minimum CGPA requirement for continuing and getting assistantship in M. Tech./M. Plan./MBA programme is 6.0 If a M. Tech./M. Plan./MBA student secures a CGPA between 5.0 and 6.0 she/he may be allowed to continue in the next semester on the recommendation of the DPGC and with the approval of the SPGB. However these students shall complete all the other requirements at the time of passing out. The minimum CGPA requirement upto the last i.e. 13th Convocation for award of degrees to PG students was 6.00. SPGB in its 43rd meeting held on 18th July 2019 deliberated on the issue of reducing the minimum CGPA requirement for award of PG degrees and resolved that for awarding degree to the M.Tech./M.Plan./MBA minimum CGPA requirement should be reduced to 5.5 instead of 6.00. During the Academic year 2018-19 two students have been awarded provisional degree on the basis of the above recommendation of SPGB after approval of Chairman Senate.
