Minutes of the 43<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Board of Governors held on 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2020at 12:00 AM in Board Room, Prabha Bhawan, MNIT, Jaipur

The 43<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Board of Governors held on 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 at 12:00 AM in Board Room, Prabha Bhawan, MNIT, Jaipur chaired by Prof. Udaykumar R Yaragatti, Director, MNIT Jaipur as the term of Chairperson was ended and new Chairperson has not been appointed, the Director as per the Clause 17 (15) of NIT Statutes discharged the function of the Chairperson. The Members at Serial No. 1, 2 & 5 joined the meeting on video call.

At the outset, the Chairperson welcomed all present in the meeting, Ms. Darshana M. Dabral, Member (JS & FA, IFD, MHRD) and Director, IIT Delhi was not present due to their prior engagements and leave of absence was granted to them.

Subsequently agenda items were taken one by one: -

To confirm the minutes of the 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 of Item No. 43-1.0: the Board of Governors.

The minutes of the 43<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the Board were confirmed.

To note the action taken on the decisions made in the 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting held Item No. 43-2.0: on 20th August, 2018 of the Board of Governors.

The Action Taken was noted.

Regarding Point No. 42-2.0 (42-3.15), the Board suggested to issue a memorandum to invite fresh application for grant of HAG with cutoff date 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 as per MHRD guidelines and place the recommendations of Selection Committee in BoG.

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Item No. 43-3.0: Items for consideration.

Item No. 43-3.1: To consider the revised estimate for construction of Boy's Hostel.

The Board approved the revised estimate for construction of Boy's Hostel of Rs.44.26 Cr..

Item No. 43-3.2: To consider the proposal of re-carpeting of campus roads.

The Board was apprised that for re-carpeting of campus roads, the funds will be provided from the unutilized Grant in Aid 35. Thus the Board approved the proposal.

Item No. 43-3.3: To consider the details of Construction work of Vivekanand Lecture Theatre Complex (VLTC).

The following Comments received from Deputy Secretary (Finance), MHRD dated 17.01.2020:

The tender agreement was between CPWD and the contractor. However, in the Agenda, no document is available containing justification furnished by the CPWD certifying that there was no delay on the part of the contractor. It has been mentioned in the Agenda that approval of the  $27^{th}$  BoG was taken for additional cost of Rs. 7 crore w.r.t. the project. However, it is seen from the Minutes of  $27^{th}$  meeting of the BoG that the BoG only noted the Minutes of the  $24^{th}$  BWC and that may be not be taken as specific approval of the BoG without bringing before the BoG as a separate Agenda Item for approval. It is also seen that the BWC approved additional cost of Rs. 6.54 crore due to deviation and extra items and no approval of the BOG was taken. Thus, the cost of the project was increased by Rs. 13.54 crore without approval of the competent authority i.e. BoG. The issue raised in the CAG Audit objection was why payment to the contractor was not withheld for not achieving physical milestones by imposing liquidation of damages / penalty as per the terms and conditions of the contract.

In view of the above position, the withheld amount of the contractor may not be released and the Institute is required to take necessary action in consultation with the CPWD to ascertain the exact amount which is to be imposed on the contractor as liquidation of damages / penalty keeping in view the terms and conditions of the contract.

The above comments of Ministry and the facts were apprised to the Board and after deliberation the opinion and decision of the Board was as under:

- The construction work of Vivekanand Lecture Theatre Complex at MNIT Jaipur was awarded to M/s KMV Projects Limited through open tender by MNIT Jaipur and not through CPWD. The project cost was Rs. 82.65 Crore, which was approved / recommended by 19<sup>th</sup> BWC and was taken on record in 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting of BoG held on 23.03.2012.
- 2. After tender the cost of project came to Rs. 61.97 Crores and the cost of additional creation of space was Rs. 7.00 Crores which was approved as Table Agenda in 27<sup>th</sup> BoG vide Agenda Item No. 27-7.10.

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- 3. The date of completion of project was 11.11.2014 but due to additional work and hindrances actually completed on 17.09.2016 after a delay of 690 days.
- 4. The contractor submitted the delay statement of 2091 days, due to hindrances in completion of work. The Institute level Committee examined the hindrances report and total 691 days delay was found justified.
- 5. The BWC in its 29<sup>th</sup>& 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting vide Item No. 29-4.16 & 32-3.7 held on 03.10.2015, recommended deviation of Rs. 6.55 Crore in the work. Further, 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting of BWC held on 19.12.2017 examined the time extension case of VLTC project and approved it for 691 days without compensation due to justified hindrances.
- 6. The total project cost comes to Rs. 75.52 Crore including additional work, extra items and deviation, which is well within the approved budget of the project.

As per above facts, the Board approved the following:

- 1. Approved the total project cost Rs.75.52 Crore (including the cost of additional work, extra items and deviation), which is within the sanctioned limit of Rs. 82.65 Crore.
- 2. The time extension for completion of work is granted upto 691 days without compensation due to justified hindrances.
- Item No. 43-3.4:

To consider the Confidential Report of High level Committee constituted for the complaint under "PIDR" against Dr. I. K. Bhat, Ex-Director, MNIT Jaipur.

The Board deliberated on the matter and was agreed to the decision of High Level Committee and directed to send the report to the Ministry.

Item No. 43-3.5:

To consider the number eligible students for award of degree in UG, PG and Ph.D. programmes in the 14th Convocation.

The Board approved the list of eligible students for award of degree under UG, PG and Ph.D. programmes.

Item No. 43-3.6:

To consider the names of the studentsfor award of Gold Medals in the respective UG and PG programmes.

The Board approved the list of students who attained highest CGPA in the Academic Year 2018-19 in respective UG / PGprogrammes for award of Gold Medals.

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## Item No. 43-3.7: To consider the recruitment process for the post of Assistant Professor AGP 6000 / Level 10.

The Board noted the detailed process of recruitment. The Board approved the recommendations of Selection Committees. The details of number of candidates selected in respective departments are as under:
