'Audience: A Film Screening and Discussion' on November 22, 2022

The Oscarnominated Short Film "Kavi" was screened and left for open discussion amongst scholars. KAVI is the story of a little boy whose father is an indentured enslaved person because he owes money to the enslaver. According to the discussion held after the movie screening, the following comments and observations emanated:

- 1. "The movie is very well structured".
- 2. "Every aspect of the movie is elegant and compelling. It rushes and captures and holds the viewer's attention".
- 3. It encapsulates a harsh, disguised reality of India.

The movie portrays how a man searching for food, and shelter can be forced to reduce himself to mere crumbles, quickly bounced between society's capitalist and money-minded people. In such scenarios, men, women and children are trapped in slavery and work as imprisoned labourers. The movie poignantly displayed this hard-to-digest reality. The session was left open for peer learning through open discussions and deliberations on the concerns the film addresses.
