



A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION BETWEEN THE MALAVIYA NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF GREENWICH

In the interests of establishing a relationship of mutual benefit to both organisations, the Malaviya National Institute of Technology Jaipur (MNIT), India and the University of Greenwich (UOG), United Kingdom agree to develop educationally related activities as outlined below.

The principal purpose of the understanding is to cooperate to establish a variety of academic arrangements that will be to the mutual benefit of both staff and students of the two institutions.

These activities may relate to:

jointly developing programmes, primarily at postgraduate level, in management, engineering, computing and information technology and architecture and building technology

the exchange of faculty members from each institution to engage in research and curriculum development

faculty members from each institution conducting teaching and/or research at the partner's University

enabling students from MNIT or UOG to visit the other institution to undertake projects and to participate in symposia

enabling students from MNIT or the UOG to progress to further study at either of the institutions.

Arrangements shall be made for both institutions to ensure they maintain adequate contact, communication, and the exchange of information to enhance the understanding.

Arrangements shall be made to ensure both institutions establish appropriate administrative and management processes involved in the recruitment, counselling, learning and any transfer of students on the programmes

During the course of any future agreement, if circumstances should arise that are not stated in any such agreement, the two institutions shall solve them through friendly discussion.

This Memorandum of Understanding commences when signed and dated by the representatives of the two institutions.
